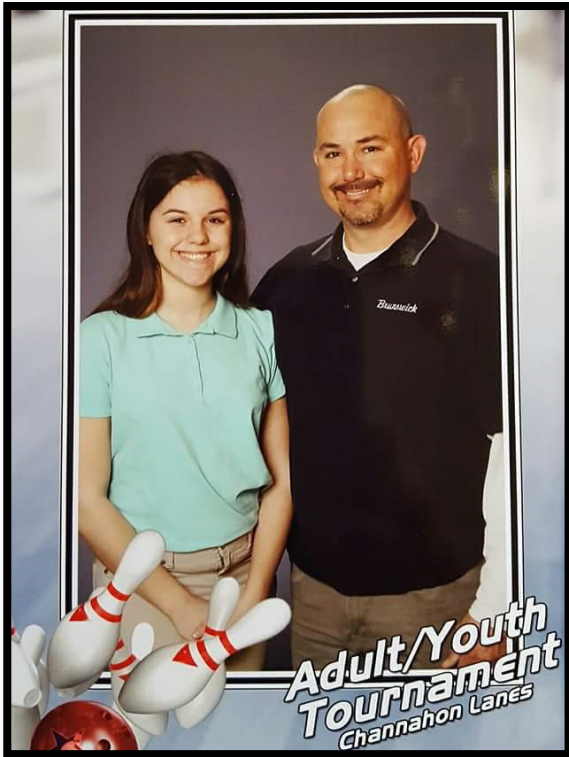




# *On The Lanes With...*
